Performing a variety of genres from barbershop, to contemporary pop, to classical, to vocal jazz, Sirens of Gotham takes pride in performing all kinds of a cappella music with precision and heartfelt artistry. The ensemble has accomplished much since its establishment in November 2011, but has grown exponentially since February 2013, when Sirens of Gotham became a chartered chapter of Sweet Adelines International (SAI). Within SAI Region 15, the Sirens have claimed the title of Div. A (Small Chorus) Champions three times, and most recently won 3rd place overall and a 2nd Place Div. AA (Midsize Chorus) finish at the 2019 Regional Convention, where they also won Most Improved Chorus for the second time! In October 2018, they made their international competition debut at the SAI Harmony Classic barbershop chorus competition in St. Louis, MO, winning 1st place Div. A and overall!

Voices of Gotham is a not-for-profit men's chorus whose mission is to celebrate, promote, and advance the rich American tradition of barbershop harmony.
